





- Larger codebase
- More dependencies (on external libraries)
- All* OOP code & design patterns
- Symfony-framework based HTTP Kernel
- Dependency Injection





- Ongoing maintenance costs
- Specialized (expensive) hosting
- Specialized (expensive) developers
- Migration from version to version (not upgrades)

- 1. Minimize unnecessary change
- 2. Architect for the majority (code)
- 3. Design for the majority (features)
- 4. Provide extensibility
- 5. Keep low system requirements
- 6. Issue planned and measured releases
- 7. Always remain free and **Open Source**


